Urban Farming by The Integrated Farmers

The Integrated Farmers embarked on a journey in sustainable urban farming in January 2022, utilising their limited land space for vertical farming aquaponics. They employed this method to cultivate high-quality nutritious produce for consumption.

A stroke of inspiration came from a close family friend who suggested they raise chickens to control pests while generating a consistent income stream. Intrigued, they ventured into basic chicken husbandry, marking a new chapter in their journey on exploring sustainable farming approaches. Today, alongside raising chickens, they have set up vermicomposting systems to utilise organic waste efficiently which focuses on creating nutrient-rich compost through the power of earthworms.



The Integrated Farmers are passionate cultivators of premium free-range native chickens, envisioning their poultry as the "wagyu of chicken." This is coupled with ethical farming practices as their cornerstone, which places great importance on propagating cruelty-free practices when caring for the chickens and the environment alike. Meanwhile, their vermicomposting efforts produce natural fertilisers that enrich their crops and support a closed-loop ecosystem, eliminating the need for chemical fertilisers which are harmful to the environment and detrimental to health when consumed by customers.

Their distinctive ethos focuses on coexistence between the environment and practical farming methods which allows their farm to host a myriad of native wildlife species. Critters like snakes and lizards are common visitors and they help the Integrated Farmers with organic pest control, completely removing the need for pesticides and rodenticides.

As their tale continues to unfold, The Integrated Farmers captivate hearts with premium produce grown with care and conscience. Rooted in sustainability and a genuine love for land preservation, their inspiring story resonates with all who value ethical farming, nature's delicate harmony, and the transformative power of vermicomposting.
